#### **ETFs**

Exchange Traded Funds (ETFs) are big collections of shares which are pooled together into one easy to manage basket.


They can track a stock market index, such as the FTSE 100 or even a sector

- ☐ Investment vehicle of choice in the USA
- ☐ Assets over \$3 trn in the USA
- ☐ Investors can buy or sell at any time of the trading day at a known price
- ☐ Typically much cheaper to own than a mutual fund
